Rules for full paper submission

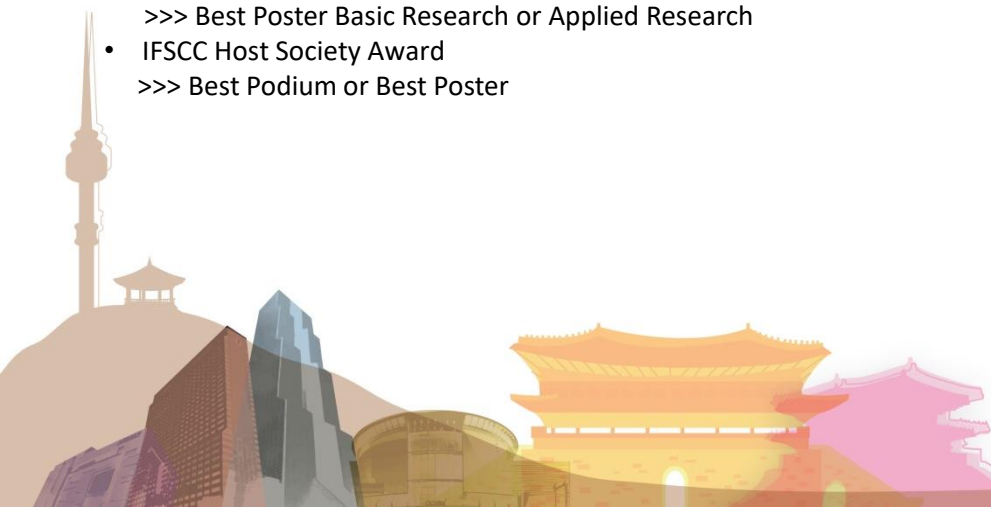
- All full papers are to be submitted by July 31, 2017 .
- Full papers should be written in English and not exceed 5,000 words.
- Illustrations, charts and table can be included.
- Authors must clarify in writing that the paper is original.
- Upload the file on 'my page' of the official website(<http://ifsc2017.iloveweb.kr/>) in PDF Format.
- Conflict of Interest Disclosure and Declaration of publication should be submitted.
- Full papers should not contain commercial trade names.
- The mentioning of trade names of equipment used is allowed unless the intention of the presentation (paper or poster) is to promote the use of equipment.
- The presentation should be completely scientific and should not promote you or your company in any manner.

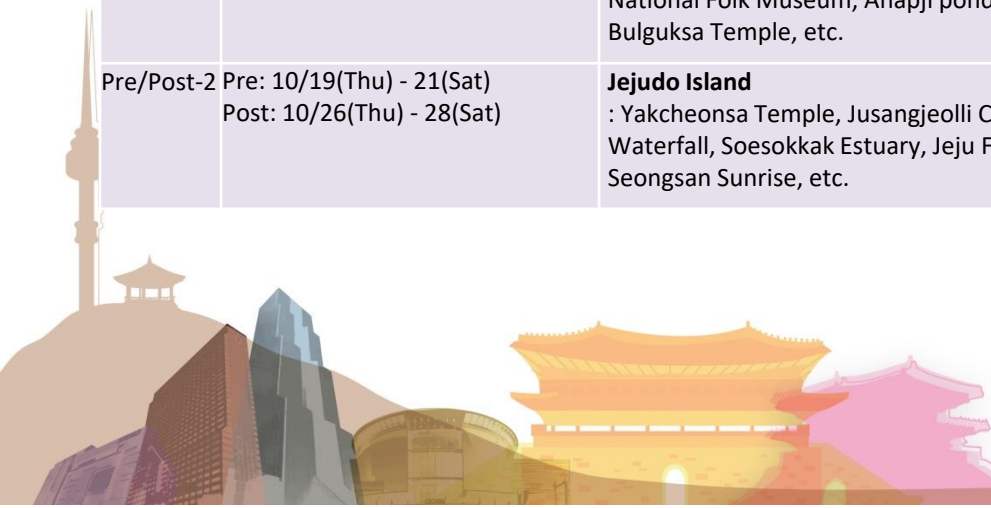
